Item #1 of 2: Numbering Error

Vendor Question: There are 2 Sections identified as 2.1.1.1, page 12 WAN Sites and Page 13 Different Bandwidth Requirements. Please explain.

Answer: Yes, that's a numbering error. The section on page 13 titled Different Bandwidth Requirements should be numbered 2.1.1.3. There are no other references to this section throughout the RFP, so this does not affect any response.

Item #2 of 2: Address correction

Vendor Question: UHA1 shows the site name of Kingwood and has a phone number for Kingwood. The address however is a Morgantown address. Where is this site?

Answer: Sites UHA1 and UHA2 should have the following information:
